

MINUTES

ON MARCH 20, 2023 AT 6:30 PM THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL HELD A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING AT THE TOWN HALL COMPLEX. PRESIDING OVER THE MEETING WAS MAYOR BILLY CHAVIS. ALSO PRESENT FOR THE MEETING WERE COUNCILPERSONS DAVID BARBER, GEORGE SUMMERSON AND LEANNE TROUTMAN. MAYOR CHAVIS CALLED THE MEETING TO ORDER AND BEGAN BY PROVIDING THE INVOCATION. COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN MADE A MOTION TO APPROVE THE AGENDA AS POSTED. COUNCILPERSON BARBER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION.

TOWN CLERK, PAM HYMAN, CONDUCTED THE 1ST READING OF A PETITION REQUESTING THE ANNEXATION OF PROPERTY UNDER 100% ANNEXATION METHOD AND ASSIGNING AN INTERIM ZONING CLASSIFICATION; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO. THE PROPERTY PETITIONING TO BE ANNEXED IS LOCATED AT 2428 EUTAW ROAD AND BELONGS TO WILLIAM T. THORNLEY. COUNCILPERSON BARBER MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE PETITION AS PRESENTED TO COUNCIL. COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION.

TOWN CLERK, PAM HYMAN, THEN CONDUCTED THE 1ST READING OF AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF HANGAR GROUND LEASES; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATING THERETO. COUNCILPERSON BARBER MADE A MOTION TO ACCEPT THE ORDINANCE AS READ. COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN SECONDED THE MOTION.

MAYOR CHAVIS THEN ASKED COUNCIL FOR A MOTION TO HIRE THOMAS & HUTTON CONSULTING SERVICES TO PROVIDE CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS OF OLD STATE ROAD IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF HOLLY HILL. COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN MADE A MOTION TO HIRE THOMAS & HUTTON CONSULTING SERVICES FOR THE STREETScape IMPROVEMENTS OF OLD STATE ROAD IN THE DOWNTOWN AREA OF HOLLY HILL. COUNCILPERSON SUMMERSON SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION.
