

MINUTES

ON AUGUST 8, 2022 AT 6:00 PM THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL HELD A PUBLIC HEARING AT THE TOWN HALL COMPLEX. THE PURPOSE OF THE MEETING WAS FOR A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWN OF HOLLY HILL, SOUTH CAROLINA TO APPLY TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, RURAL DEVELOPMENT FOR FUNDING AND EVIDENCING SUPPORT FOR THE PURCHASE OF TWO NEW POLICE VEHICLES; AND OTHER MATTERS RELATED THERETO. PRESIDING OVER THE HEARING WAS MAYOR BILLY CHAVIS. ALSO PRESENT FOR THE HEARING WERE COUNCILPERSONS LEANNE TROUTMAN, CYNTHIA FULLER, AND GEORGE SUMMERSON. THE HEARING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR CHAVIS.

THE FLOOR WAS OPENED FOR PUBLIC COMMENTS REGARDING THE RESOLUTION (SIGN IN SHEET ATTACHED). CITIZEN WILLIAM JOHNSON ASKED THE AMOUNT THE TOWN WAS SEEKING TO WHICH CHIEF DETTER RESPONDED, "THE USUAL \$80,000.". CITIZEN SHAUN DALEY ASKED IF THE VEHICLES WERE GOING TO BE NEW OR USED AND WOULD THEY HAVE WARRANTIES ON THEM TO WHICH MAYOR CHAVIS RESPONDED, "YES, THEY WILL BE NEW FROM A DEALERSHIP AND WILL HAVE THE SAME WARRANTY AS MOST DEALERSHIPS OFFER." THERE WERE NO COMMENTS IN FAVOR OR OPPOSITION. AT THIS TIME, THE PUBLIC HEARING WAS ADJOURNED.
