

MINUTES


ON MAY 17, 2021 THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL HELD A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING VIA CONFERENCE CALL TO PHONE # 1-978-990-5457 AND USING CODE: 6976820. PRESIDING OVER THE MEETING WAS MAYOR WILLIAM JOHNSON. ALSO PRESENT FOR THE MEETING WERE COUNCILPERSONS LEANNE TROUTMAN, CYNTHIA FULLER (VIA PHONE), DAVID BARBER (VIA PHONE), AND GEORGE SUMMERSON. THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER BY MAYOR JOHNSON. THE INVOCATION WAS GIVEN BY MAYOR JOHNSON.

MAYOR JOHNSON BEGAN THE MEETING BY ANNOUNCING THE GOVERNOR LIFTED THE EMERGENCY ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE USE OF FACE COVERINGS, THEREFORE, THE TOWN'S FACE COVERING ORDINANCE IS AUTOMATICALLY LIFTED AS WELL. MAYOR JOHNSON STATED A MOTION IS NOT NEEDED AS THIS IS AN AUTOMATIC ACTION BASED ON THE GOVERNOR'S EXECUTIVE ORDER.

MAYOR JOHNSON THEN DISCUSSED WITH COUNCIL THE POSSIBILITY OF OPENING THE TOWN'S PUBLIC VENUES. COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN MADE A MOTION TO OPEN THE TOWN'S PUBLIC VENUES BEGINNING JUNE 1, 2021. COUNCILPERSON BARBER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION. MAYOR JOHNSON THEN ADDED THE TOWN WILL NOT HONOR ANY PREVIOUS REQUESTS FOR RESERVING THE VENUES. THEY WILL BE RENTED ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.

MAYOR JOHNSON CONCLUDED BY ANNOUNCING THE REGULAR SCHEDULED COUNCIL MEETINGS WILL GO BACK TO MEETING IN PERSON BEGINNING WITH THE JUNE 7, 2021 MEETING.

BEING NO FURTHER BUSINESS TO DISCUSS, COUNCILPERSON TROUTMAN MADE A MOTION TO ADJOURN. COUNCILPERSON BARBER SECONDED THE MOTION. ALL VOTED IN FAVOR OF THE MOTION AND THE MEETING ADJOURNED.
